Paul Joseph Dickman, age 72 of Madison passed away June 28, 2013. Paul was born on January 9, 1941 in Nashville to the late Raymond L. and Margaret Dickman. 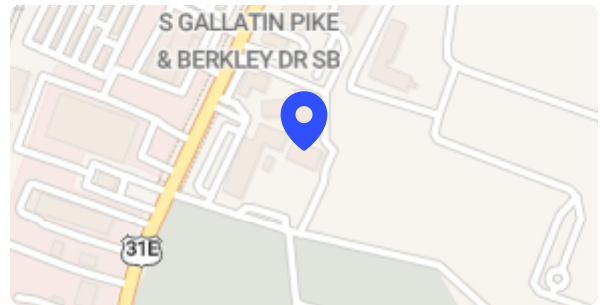
