**M**rs. Betty Barnes Peak Stewart, 86, passed away on Sunday, March 9th, 2014. Born to parents Clifton D. and Thelma L. Roberson Barnes on January 12, 1928 in Nashville, TN. Betty was raised in Old Hickory, TN where she attended elementary school and graduated from DuPont High School in 1946. She graduated with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Education from Carson Newman College and earned a Master's Degree from the University of Colorado (Ext.) in 1975. She was an elementary teacher for 40 years, retiring from Metro Nashville Public Schools in 1992. She was an active Christian since age 10, and an active member of Parkway Baptist Church for 35 years. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her brother, William 'Bill' R. Barnes (2013). She is survived by her devoted husband, Ray D. Stewart, her son, Dr. James F. Peak (Paige) of Richmond, VA and her daughter, Melissa Peak Haefele(Alan) of Franklin, TN. 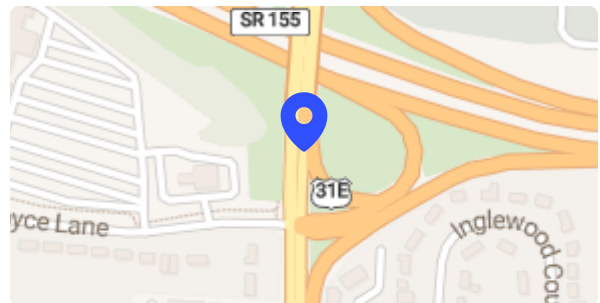
