## **Mr. Harold M. Randall**

**M**r. Harold M. Randall, 86, former long-time resident of Poway, California and of Franklin, Tennessee since July, died Friday December 5, 2014 at NHC Place at Cool Springs.

The former Illinois native was the son of Luella and Ray Randall of Freeport Illinois. Mr. Randall was a US Army veteran. From modest upbringing, Mr. Randall was employed by Newell Inc. now Newell-Rubbermaid where he worked his way up the management chain to Division Operations Vice President. Mr. Randall retired from Newell Rubbermaid in 1993 after 49 years with the company. 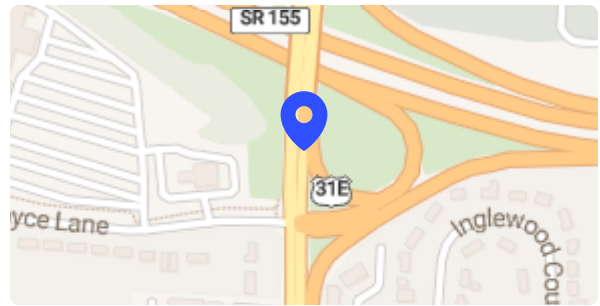
