Obituary for Mrs. Leah "Peggy" Brown

Leah Francis Brown, best known as "Peggy Brown", passed away peacefully at age 95 on Thursday, January 15, 2015.

She was born April 23, 1919 in Nashville, TN to the late Charles Monroe and Ora Lee Anderson. She was preceded in death by her loving husband of fifty years, Vernon Lee Brown. She had 4 children: Charlene Adamson, deceased, and survived by 3 children: Carol Wamble, Mike Brown (wife: Pam Brown) and Ruth Griffin. She had 9 grandchildren, 13 great-grandchildren and 3 great-great grandchildren.

Peggy Brown was an active member of Hendersonville Church of Christ where her husband Vernon was an elder for many years. She was a devoted wife, mother and homemaker but also involved with community activities such as Brownie and Girl Scout Leader, garden clubs as well as an active member of the Civitan Ladies Auxiliary. 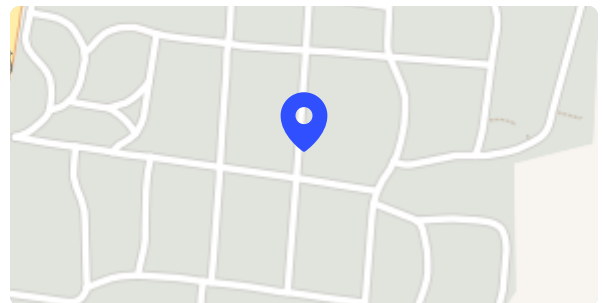
