**R**udolph "Rudy" Fulghum, age 103, of Goodlettsville, passed away Sunday, March 15, 2015. He was born July 19, 1911 in Kingston Springs, TN to the late Eugene and Evie Dillingham Fulghum. Besides his parents, he is also preceded in death by his wife of 73 ½ years, Gladys Odum Fulghum, who was the star in his eye and the love of his life. Rudy was a member of Inglewood Baptist Church since 1936 where he served as a deacon and church treasurer and he regularly attended the Dudley Miller Sunday School Class. He was the oldest graduate of Nashville Central High School and retired in 1976 from Swift Packing Company where he worked as a supervisor. 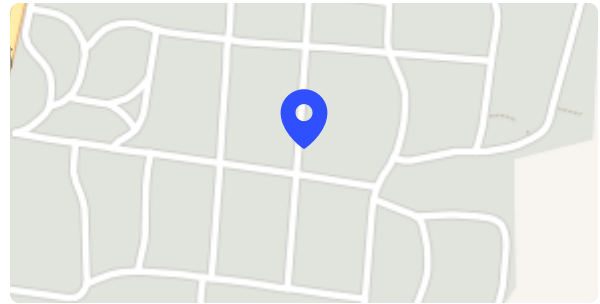

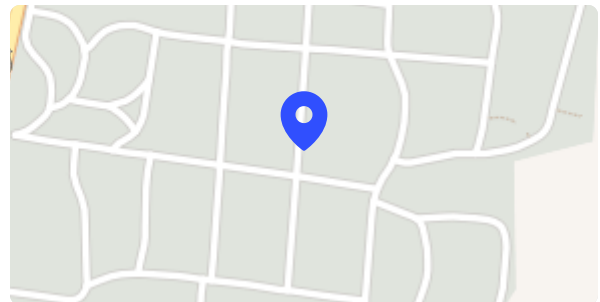

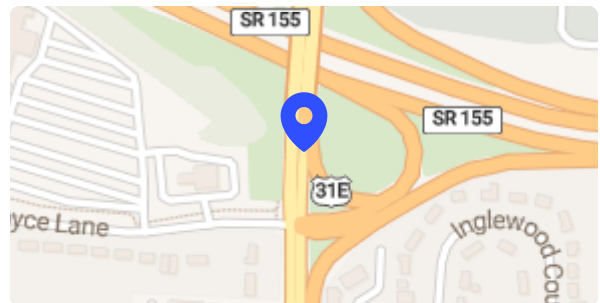
