Bob was a loving husband, father and grandfather who will be greatly missed. His family describes him as being a "Riot" with his endless humor and joking nature. Bob served his country in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War. For his honorable service to his country he was decorated with several medals which include the Bronze Star Medal and Purple Heart. Later in life, he retired from Bellsouth after 33 years of service.

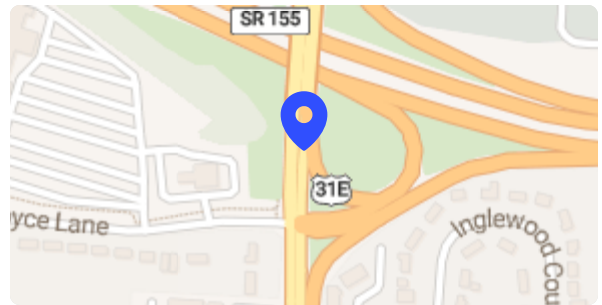
