No flowers please.

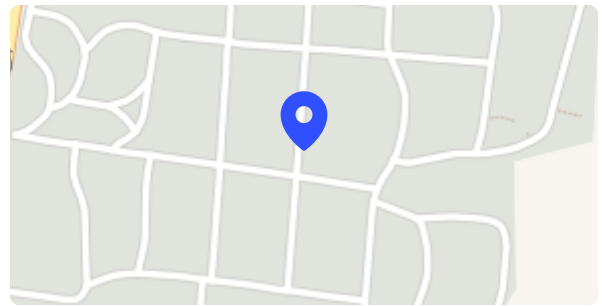
