A graveside service for Harlem will be held 2pm on Monday, August 15, 2016

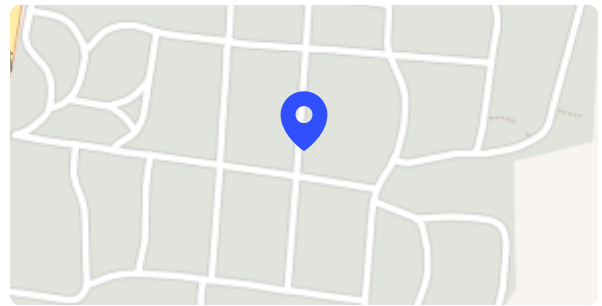
