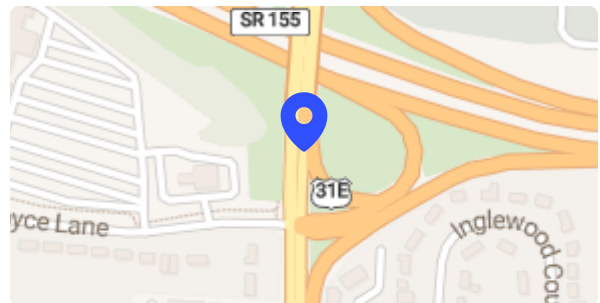

Joe was a great neighbor and will truly be missed. Rest In Peace my friend.Wanda Driver

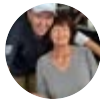
