The family requests that donations be made to the Nashville Rescue Mission or Inglewood Baptist Church.

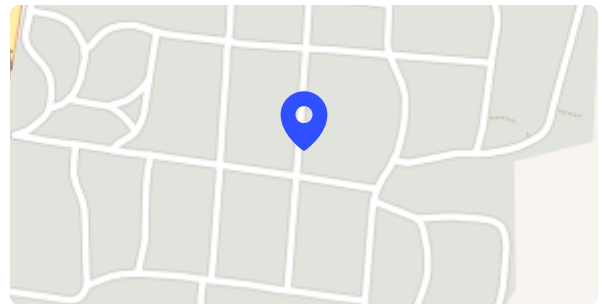
