Ronald Keith Burnett, age 69, of Nashville, Tennessee, went to his Heavenly Home on Friday, May 19, 2017 after a long battle with cancer. Ron was known for his devotion to his wife, family, and friends. Ron's firm faith in God both strengthened him and inspired others for the duration of his cancer fight.

Ron was born on January 28, 1948 in Nashville, Tennessee. He was a graduate of Maplewood High School where he was well known throughout the city for his skill on the athletic fields, particularly basketball. After graduation, he continued his education at both Vincennes Junior College and Memphis State University on basketball scholarships. Following college he enlisted in the United States Navy where he proudly served his country. Professionally, Ron spent many years working for Aladdin Industries and Gaylord.

Ron married his best friend and the love of his life, Frankie Shadrick, on August 10, 1974, and their union was blessed with three children, Rhonda, Brian, and Bradley. He was the type of husband and father we all desire. He invested himself into his family by being a provider, faithful husband, coach, fisherman, mentor, and golf partner. He also poured his faith in Christ into others through his many years as Sunday School teacher, Vacation Bible School volunteer, and Spirit Sunday School Class member.
