Mrs. Musgrave was one of the original Mother's Day Out Teachers at Riverwood Church of Christ, being the only teacher that started when it opened and retired when it closed. 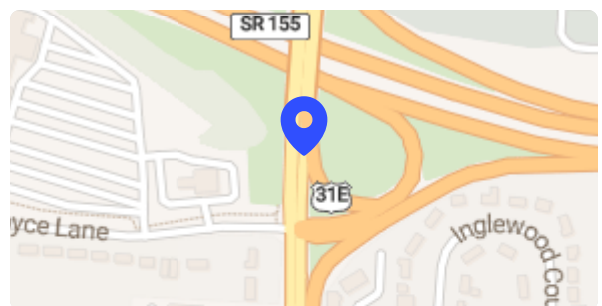
