A Celebration of Life Ceremony will be held at a later date.




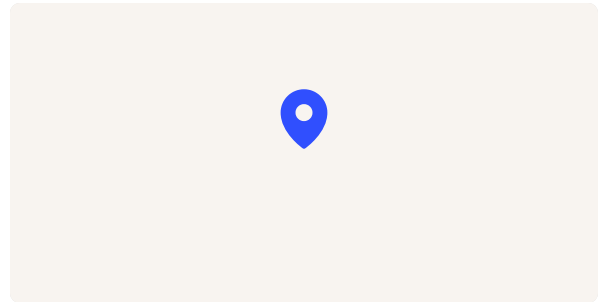
