Bobby Earl Moody, age 85, passed away on Tuesday, April 24, 2018 in Nashville, Tennessee. Bobby was born on August 12, 1932 in Union Point, Georgia to Smith Moody and Grace Lee (Norris) Moody.

Bobby served his country in the United States Air Force. He enjoyed woodworking, photography and travel. He spent his spare time working with CB radios and he had his HAM radio license WA4PRN. 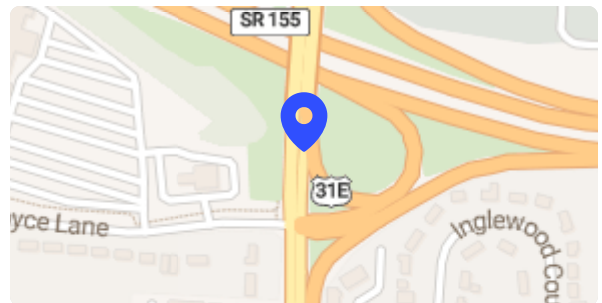
