Fric B. Dahlhauser Dies

Eric B. Dahlhauser, who had an immeasurable impact on the lives of his family and friends, died suddenly at his home in Goodlettsville, TN on Thursday, January 24, 2019. Eric who was 56 years old, will forever be known for his optimistic outlook, his kindness in supporting others through good and tough times, his contagious personality and his unmistakable laugh. Eric loved life, his family and friends and always put others before himself.

Eric is survived by his parents, Margaret and Arthur Dahlhauser; Nancy Dahlhauser, his wife of 35 years; his children Jennifer Knoll, Andrew Dahlhauser and Lauren (Benjamin) Heisler, and 5 grandchildren. Born in Schenectady, New York on August 20, 1962, Eric was a graduate of Father Ryan High School in 1980, attended Saint Ambrose College in Iowa and graduated from Middle Tennessee State University where he earned a Bachelor's degree in Accounting. He was a Certified Public Accountant, formerly serving as a founding partner with the firm of Carter, Young, Wolf and Dahlhauser.

Eric was a founder and CEO of Insight Genetics in Nashville, TN and was dedicated to improving the lives of cancer patients around the world through advanced diagnostics for precision cancer care.

A die-hard Chicago Cubs fan, Eric hung the "W" flag after every win. He annually attended numerous games at Wrigley Field with family and also his dad, Art, with whom he shared this


