**E**zra D. "Jack" Midgett, age 99, passed away on Friday, June 14, 2019 in Hendersonville, Tennessee. Jack was born on December 1, 1919 in Watertown, Tennessee to the late Ezra Wilson Midgett and Virgin (Davenport) Midgett.

Jack served his country in the United States Army. He was a humble man, this was instilled in him when he was a child, being raised on a dairy farm. He enjoyed being outdoors and seeing God's creation of where he enjoyed gardening and mowing grass. He can be remembered for being a "master" bird house builder. Jack and his wife, Pauline were both longtime members of the Madison First Baptist Church.

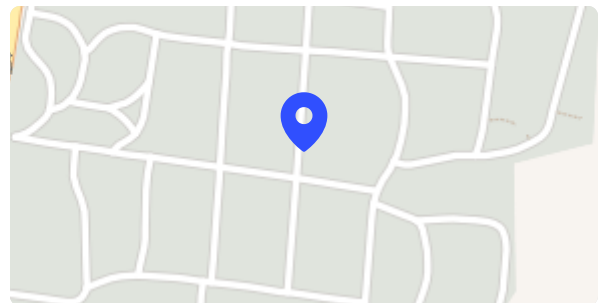

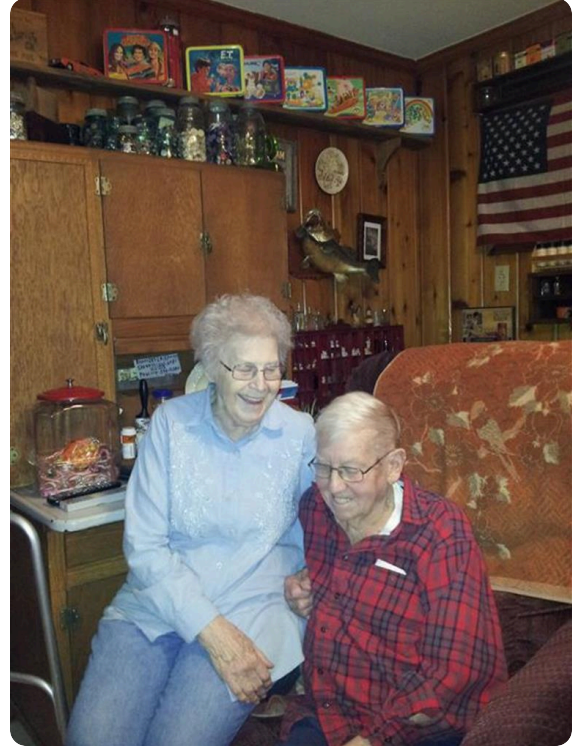
