In lieu of flowers, Suzanne requested donations be made to East End United Methodist Church.

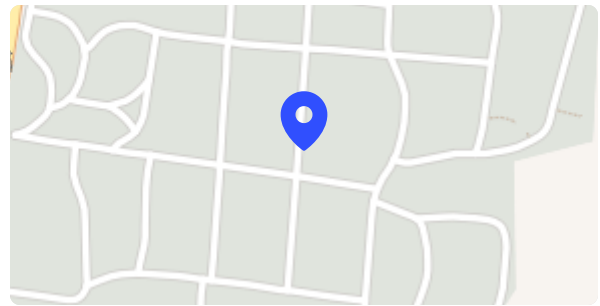
