Wayne Brown, age 78, of Hendersonville, Tennessee passed away on Sunday, July 14, 2019. Wayne was born on May 9, 1941 in Nashville, Tennessee, to the late Clifton Brown and Viva Ione Brown.

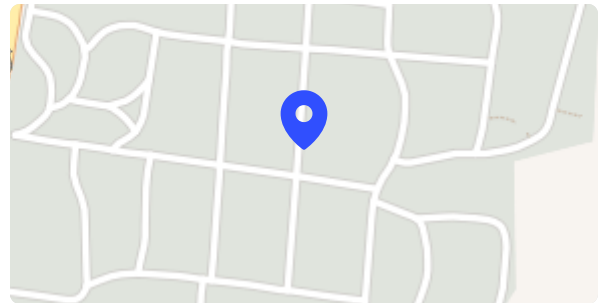

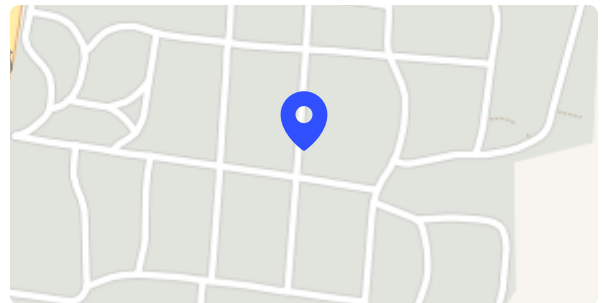

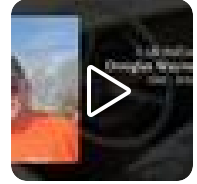
