It was there that she met Glenn Pieratt, and after a brief courtship of only six weeks, they eloped to Reno, Nevada in 1953. They were married for almost 54 years before Glenn preceded her in death in 2007. They had traveled all over the country, but settled in Portland, Tennessee, for several years before retiring to Arizona for a time.

Spring Hill Funeral Home in Madison, TN, is in charge of the arrangements.


