She will be missed dearly by her family, friends, and all who loved her.

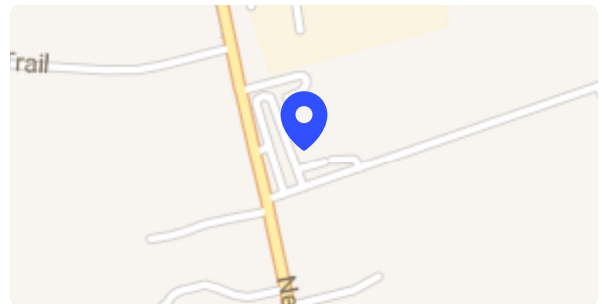

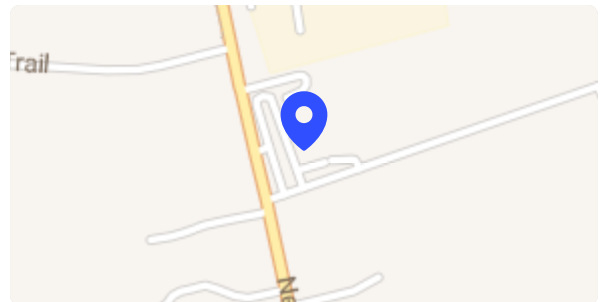
