She was a graduate of Isaac Litton High School and Ward-Belmont College. In 1950 she married her husband of 56 years, Earl Graves Pate, Jr. (deceased.)

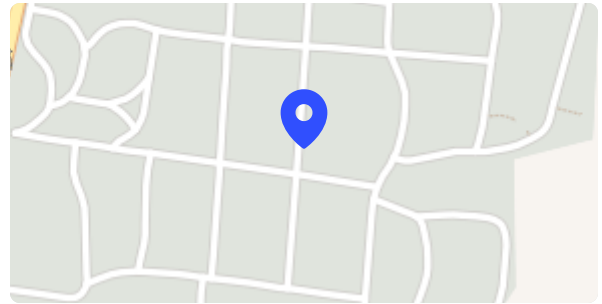

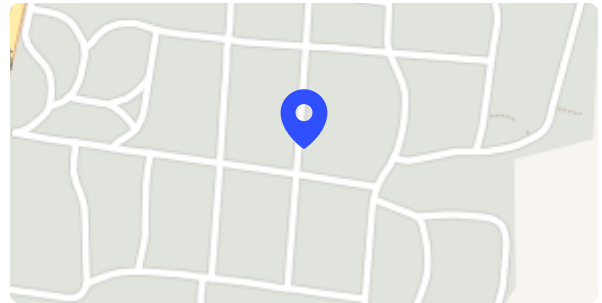

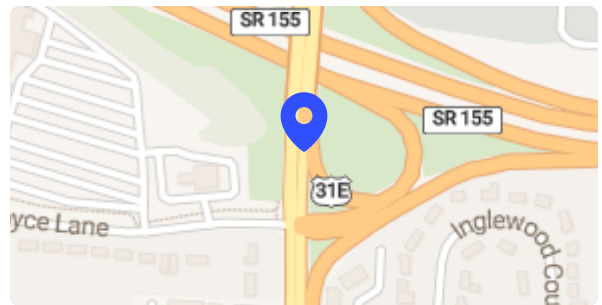
