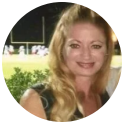
## **Mrs. Holly Jones**

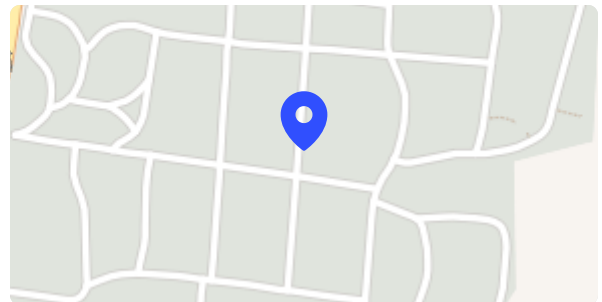

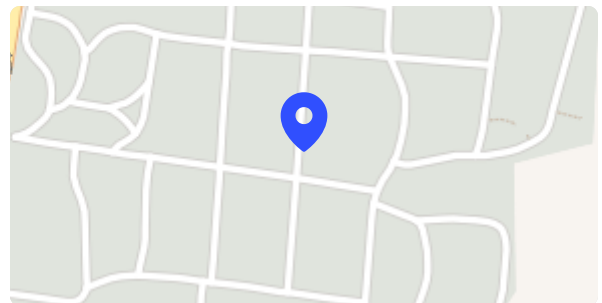

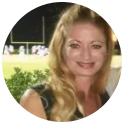
