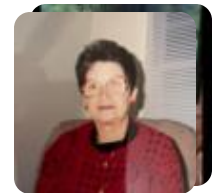
Linda Hassell Neely posted:

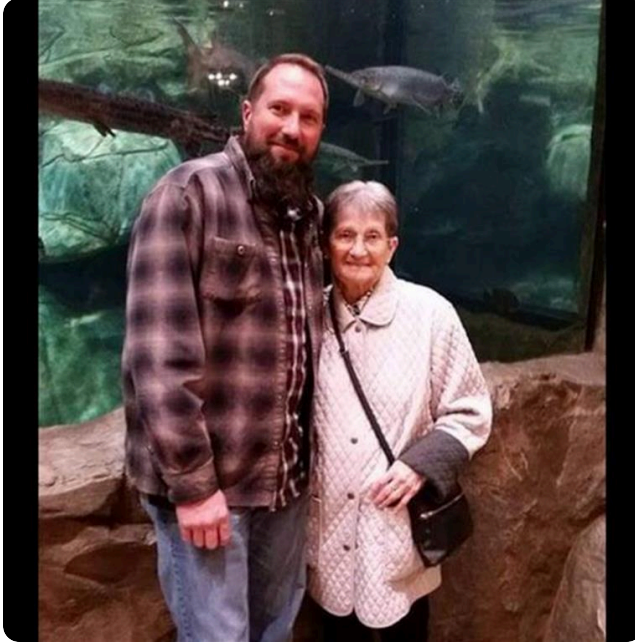
