Jerry Collins Harlan, 81, of Nashville, passed away on Monday, January 3, 2022.

Jerry was born in Columbia, TN. He graduated from Madison High School in 1958 and maintained close friendships with his many high school buddies over the years. He graduated from Tennessee Tech with a degree in mechanical engineering. He began his career at Ross Gear in Lebanon, TN and when he was bored, started building houses on the side. He couldn't tolerate an "office" job and left engineering to pursue becoming a contractor, developer and entrepreneur of many businesses such as Captain D's, Scholtzskys Delis, and Fazolis franchises, built and owned Madison and Rivergate Lodges, Harlan Development Co. and acquired many commercial and residential rental properties.

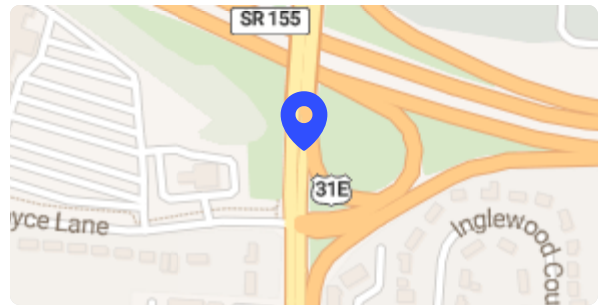
