Mrs. Delcie Mae "Dale" (Cawthron) Soyars, widow of Dr. William Hayden "Doc" Soyars, died peacefully on Saturday, May 28, 2022. She was 95 years old.

The oldest of four daughters of Lawton and Katherine Cawthron of Bedford County, Mrs. Soyars was predeceased by two of her children: Nancy Soyars (Carl) Pride and James Lawton Bailey; and is survived by three children: Katie Soyars (Graham) Baker; Jack Ernest (Carol) Soyars, and William Hayden "Buster" Soyars, II. Her youngest sister, Erma Grace "Jackie" Tidwell, of Cookeville, Tennessee also survives her.

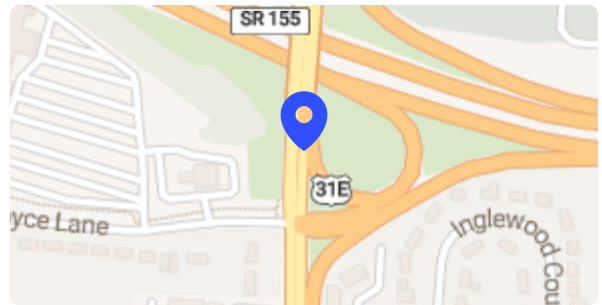
