The family is holding a private service for Eric on Saturday, July 2, 2022. A Celebration of Life memorial will be held at a later date.

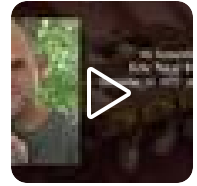

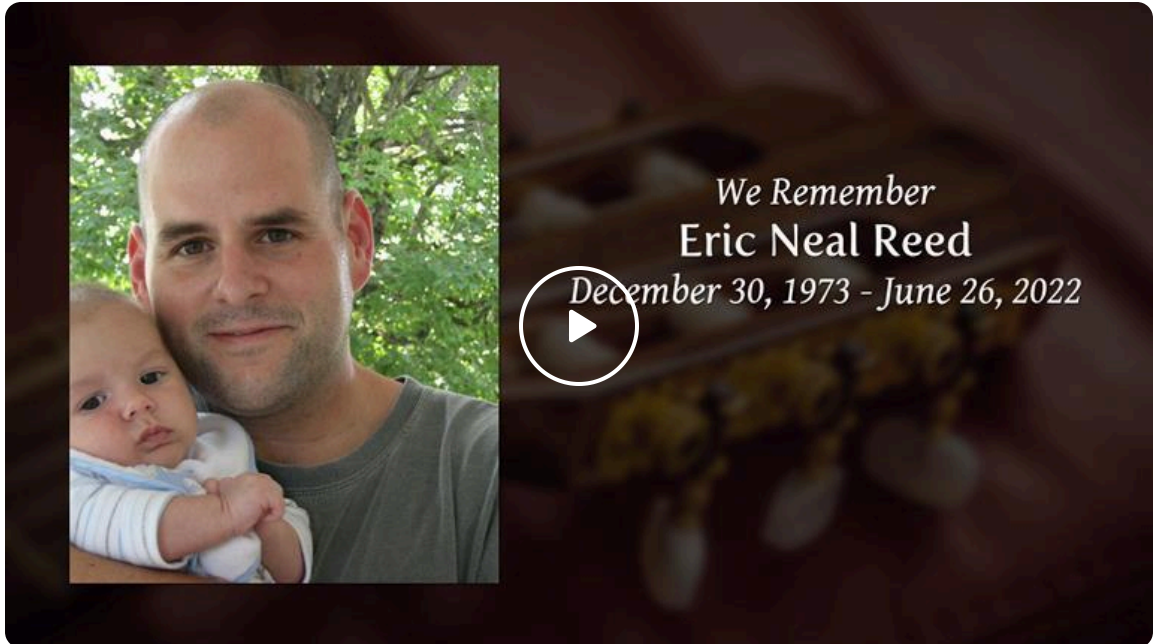
