John Thomas Johnson, 74, of Nashville, Tennessee, died on Thursday, September 15, 2022. Born April 15, 1948, in Huntsville, Alabama, he was the son of the late William Thomas Johnson and Frances Baird Johnson.

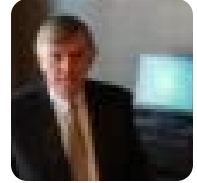
