Race was born in International Falls, MN on July 27th, 1993, to Thad and Wendy Johannessohn. Race attended Hibbing High School and graduated in 2012. He was a member of the hockey and tennis teams and loved dirt track racing and dirt biking. Race was awarded the Kappor Scholarship as the student that demonstrated the largest improvement over his senior year.

After graduation he attended college in Hibbing and Gallatin, TN and traveled to 48 states while working for Allover Media and the OOH Squad. He bounced around with his beloved boxer Allie until he landed in Clarksville, TN with the love of his life Emily Churchman. Race teamed up with his father to start Social Indoor franchises in both Clarksville and Nashville and today Social Indoor Nashville is the largest indoor advertising company in TN and one of the largest in the country. 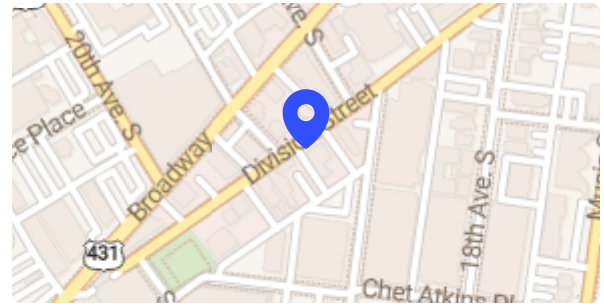

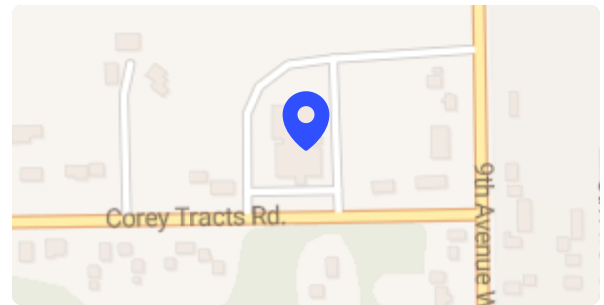

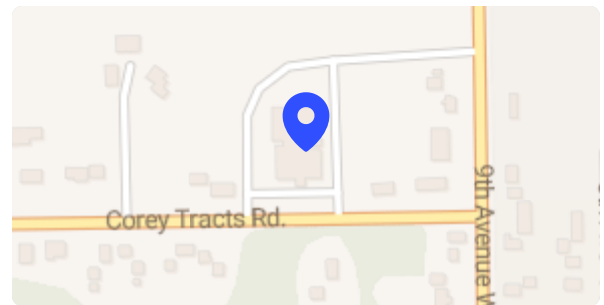
