Juanita T. Bobbitt, age 100 of Nashville, Tennessee, passed away on Monday, October 30, 2023. She was born on April 22, 1923, to the late Betty and Taylor Thompson of Putnam County TN.

In addition to her parents, she is preceded in death by the love of her life Charles R. Bobbitt, Sr. who she celebrated 72 years of marriage together. She is survived by her only son, Charles R. 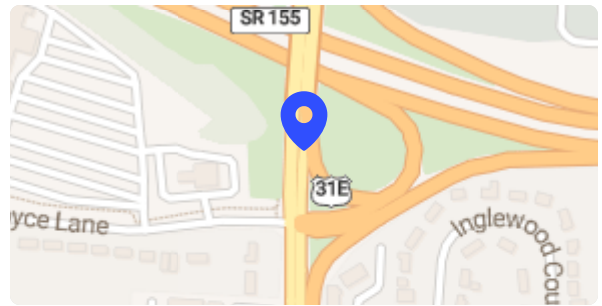
