Phyllis Maddox Watson, 89, of Purcellville, VA died peacefully in her sleep on January 3, 2024. 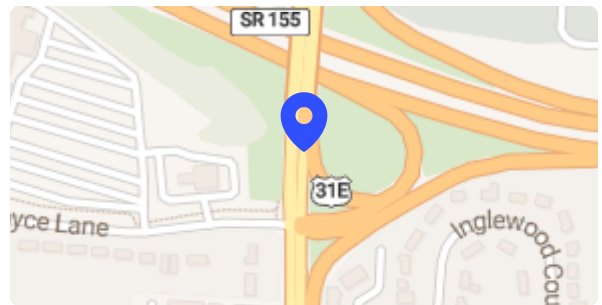
