It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Matthew Ernest Sherrill on January 19th, 2024, in Smyrna, Tennessee.

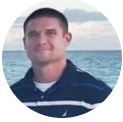

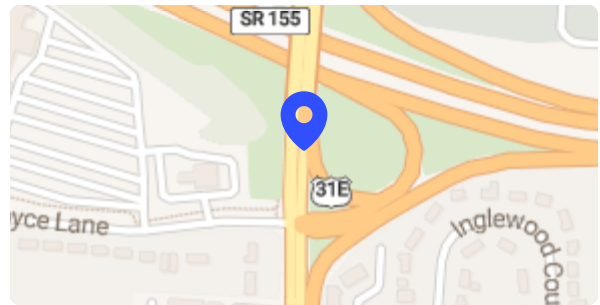
