**R**odger Allen Wooten, 53, of Crossville, TN, passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, July 6, 2024, at Vanderbilt University Medical Center in Nashville, TN. A private, family visitation will begin at 11:00 am at Ruleville Baptist Church, on Saturday, July 13, 2024, followed by a public visitation from 12:00 pm-1:00 pm. Rodger's funeral service at Ruleville Baptist Church will begin at 1:00 pm, and a graveside service will follow at Lehrton Cemetery in Ruleville, MS. Ray Funeral Home in Cleveland, MS, is in charge of the funeral service.

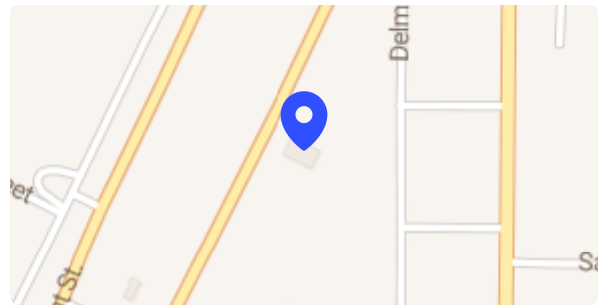

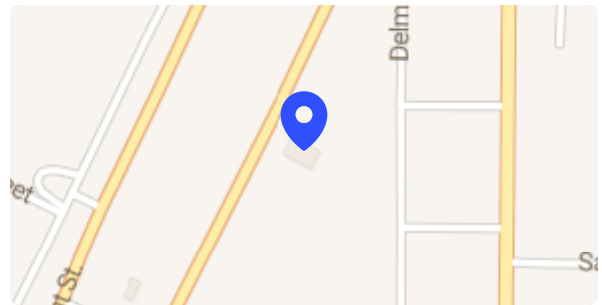
