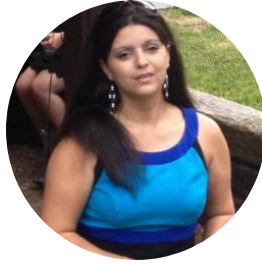

As we remember Pamela, let us celebrate the vibrant and joyful life she lived, embracing the happy memories and the positive impact she left on our hearts.



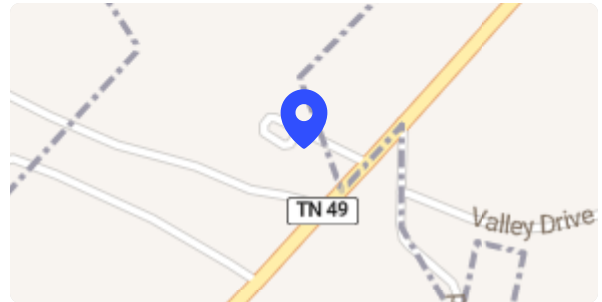

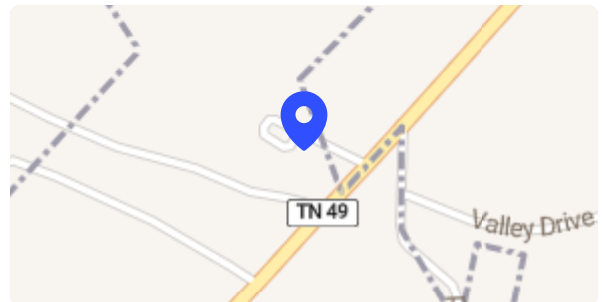
