# Nelda Juaneese Glover

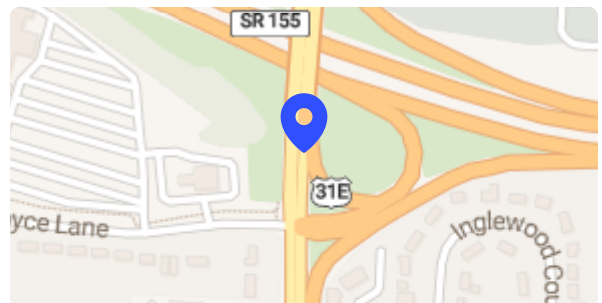
