DORR, Delmar Alton (Del) Age 82 of Nashville, TN. March 11, 2025 Del was born in Lewis-ton, Maine in August of 1942 the oldest child of Henry and Mary Dean Dorr. After high school graduation in 1960 he joined the US Air Force and served for 8 years – some of which in South Korea. After his honorable discharge he served as a minister to congregations in Florida, Nash-ville and Maine. He retired from the Tennessee State Library & Archives where he had worked for over 12 years. 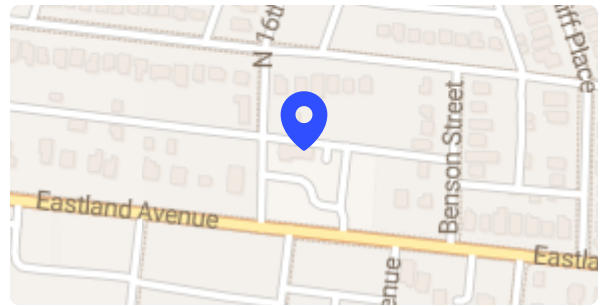

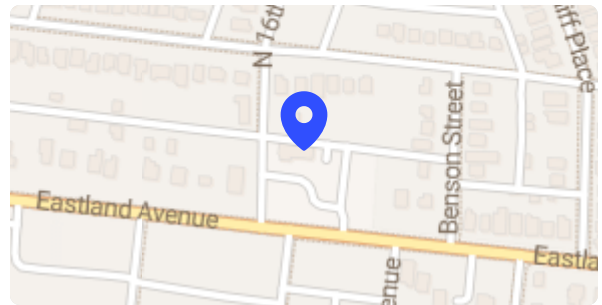
