Jackie was proud of her military service, her work in/for the Navy and enjoyed sharing her experiences. She received many awards throughout her career to include an Expert Pistol Ribbon, National Defense Service Medal, Good Conduct Award, Meritorious Unit Commendation (to include a lapel pin), and numerous Special Achievement Awards with Outstanding Performance Ratings. She completed various training programs in community colleges.

Jackie loved traveling with her nieces Becky and Amber and her friend Lisa, especially to the beach. She relocated to NC in 2017 and found peace in her home, enjoying her beautiful backyard with her dogs Daisy and Duke. 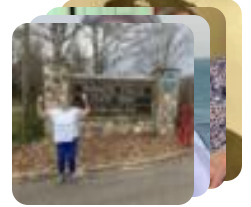

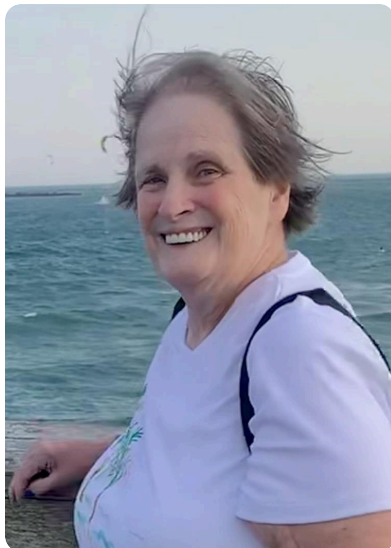
