As a child he mastered monkey bars and flips from swings, and by his teens he tackled parkour with fearless spirit. He played soccer from age four, starred on traveling teams, lettered at Bret Harte High School, and in his senior year became the varsity football team's field-goal kicker and full-time punter. Away from the field, he painted, crafted, and strummed the guitar with natural ease.

Levi yearned to travel and love for adventure took him far from home. In 2004 he and brother Eason joined parents Lynn and Mason on a three-week tour of the United Kingdom, exploring Stonehenge, the Scottish Highlands, and countless castles featured in favorite films.
