# Delmer Raymond Guinn

JUN 30, 1922 - JAN 22, 2010

**G**UINN, Delmer Raymond, Age 87, of Nashville, TN passed away January 22, 2010. He was a veteran of WWII, serving in the US Army Signal Corps in the Pacific. He was retired from the US Postal Service and a member of the Inglewood Church of the Nazarene. Delmer is preceded in death by his wife of 48 years, Juanita Lawley Guinn, and by his siblings Floral Guinn, Earl Guinn, Jamie Guinn, Evelyn Lutz, Robbie Guinn, and Christine Lawrence. He is survived by his sons Donald (Fay) Guinn of Jonesboro, AR, and Ralph (Annette) Guinn of Jay, OK; and by his daughter Laurie (Martin) Ball of Nashville.
