Church Dunlap Howlett, Sr. – Age 92, of Nashville, joined his Lord and Savior Tuesday, May 4, 2010. Preceded in death by his wife, Thelma A. Baker Howlett; mother, Alma Celia Anderson Howlett; father, Horace Polk Howlett, all of Nashville; and son, C.D. Howlett, Jr. of Greeneville, TN. Survived by his sister, Beverly Celia Fallati of Nashville; son, Jack Randell Howlett (Marilyn) of Locust Grove, VA; and three stepdaughters, Elaine Boyer Stroud, Pamela Boyer Sands (Steve) of Nashville, and Cheryl Boyer Stem (Pete) of Hermitage, TN; eleven grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren. Mr. Howlett attended East High School and was a member of Inglewood United Methodist Church for over forty years. He retired from management at Aladdin Industries, Inc., and pursued another career of over 16 years with Gray Line Tours. Mr. Howlett worked in New Orleans, LA with Vultee Aircraft Corp. during WWII after which he returned to Nashville.
