**L**uther A. May, 94, born May 11, 1916 in Guilford County, NC passed to his rest on December 31, 2010 in Madison, TN where he and his wife reside. He served as Pastor of several Seventh-day Adventist Churches with pastorates in Iowa, Tennessee and Kentucky. He served as Pastor of the Murray, Kentucky Seventh-day Adventist Church for 18 years prior to his retirement in 1994. He was a graduate of Madison College in Madison TN. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army and served in England in WWII as assistant to the Chaplain.
