Vernon Leonard Stinson age 91 passed away October 1, 2012. He was born in Williamson County, TN, the first child of Leonard and Annis Stinson. He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife of 72 years, Anna Lorena; his sister, Alma; and his daughter, Janice. Mr. Stinson is survived by sister, Hazel Lucille Mangrum; son, Larry (Marcia) of Hendersonville; son-in-law, Joe Green of Dickson; four grandchildren and five great-grandchildren. Mr. Stinson spent his early years in the Nashville and Franklin area, prior to joining the Civilian Conservation Corps in 1939.
