Ellis Owen “E. O.” Coggin, 66, Madison, Tennessee, passed from this life on Thursday, October 18, 2012, at Skyline Medical Center, following a brief battle with cancer. Born in Sheffield, Alabama, he was the son of the late Clifford Gregory Coggin, Sr. and the late Grace Evelyn Jones Coggin. Mr. Coggin was also predeceased by his paternal grandparents, W. C.
